## About The College

Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya (PDUAM), Tulungia is a Model College established under the co-venture of the Central Government and the Government of Assam. The college is an outcome of the centrally sponsored scheme named "Rashtriya Uchchattar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)" launched in 2013 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India which aims at providing strategic funding in higher educational institutions throughout the country. Funding is provided by the Central Ministry through the State Governments and Union Territories, which in coordination with the Central Project Appraisal Board, to monitor the academic, administrative and financial advancements taken under the scheme.

The college was inaugurated on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2017 by Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Honourable Health, Finance & Education Minister, Govt. of Assam. The academic session commenced on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017 and since then it has been functioning as a Model College to inculcate higher education among the rural masses of Bongaigaon district of Assam. Presently the college has a teaching strength of Fifty Two teachers serving in the three streams i.e. Commerce, Science and Arts under different departments, viz., Accountancy, Commerce (Finance), Management, English, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Assamese, Information Technology, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Education, History, Economics, Political Science and Sociology respectively. Besides, the college has a Central library and a Computer laboratory. In addition to the teaching staff, there is ten non-teaching staff in different cadre. PDUAM, Tulungia is a residential college offering hostel accommodation for girl students only.

The college is situated in close proximity to the National Highway no. 37. It is located within the vicinity of the village, Tulungia, covering an estimated area of 25 bighas of land and has a provision for further expansion. The areas surrounding the college are endowed with a substantial natural resource based on bamboo and fish ponds. Besides this, the area is acclaimed for its breathtaking scenic beauty which offers a potent scope for tourism. Majority of the villagers residing around the college are educationally and financially backward. Although, there is adequate number of schools in and around the locality, the opportunities to pursue higher education are few. The college claims to develop the intellect of our students as it offers Commerce education under the guidance of a dedicated, energetic and experienced faculty, working along with an efficient administrative staff. The transport and communication facilities in the area are convenient. The college is well connected with its district headquarter i.e. Bongaigaon as well as to the state capital.

# College Rules and Regulations

## A. General Rules:

- The Identity Card should be brought to the college every day and is to be produced whenever asked for.
- Using mobile phone inside the classroom is strictly prohibited. Violation of the rule must be liable to pay a fine or expulsion from the college or both.
- Smoking, spitting, throwing waste indecently, destroying college property, making noise and loitering in the college campus may lead pecuniary fine or expulsion from the college or both.
- Attendance in classes is compulsory. To be eligible to sit for the examinations as a regular candidate, the student should have at least 75% of attendance in classes.
- All forms of ragging in the college or in the Hostel are strictly prohibited. Strong disciplinary action will be taken against those involved in such activities.
- The decisions of competent/appropriate bodies on all matters relating to students' indiscipline shall be final and binding.
- Each academic session will run as per the Academic Calendar published by the Gauhati University.
- Chewing paan masala, gutka or any other tobacco products smoking or consumption of any other intoxicating products is strictly prohibited in and around the college campus.

## B) Examination Rules:

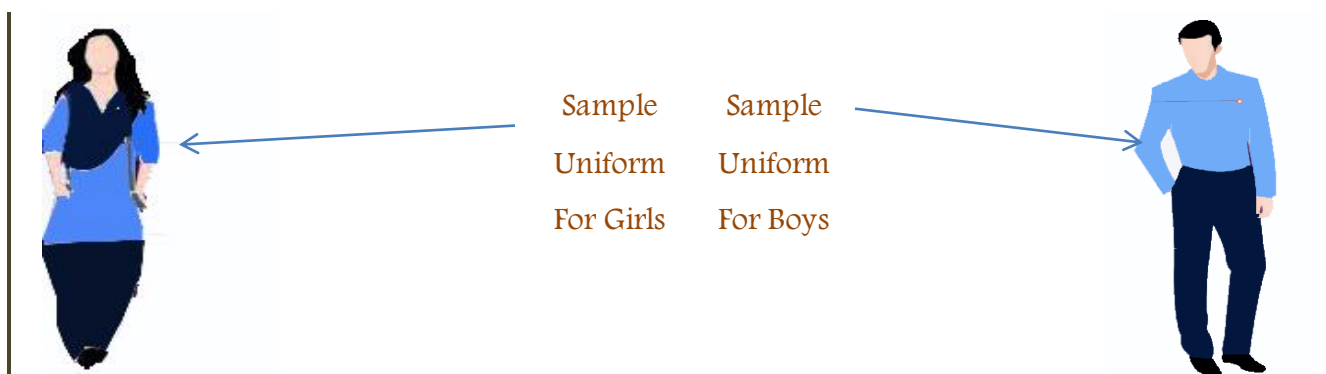
- All students must appear in Unit/Terminal/Sessional Test/Examinations conducted by the college. No student shall be allowed to fill up the final examination form without passing in test examinations. In case of illness, sick bed will be provided.
- The following examinations will be conducted by the College during an academic year:
  - Class Examinations
    - (i) HS 1st Year Unit Test and Terminal Test Examination.
    - (ii) HS 2nd Year Unit Test, Terminal and Pre Final Examination.
    - (iii) TDC semester Classes Two unit Tests and one sessional examination in each semester.
- Result of defaulters on account of College, Hostel, NCC, Sports, Student's Union, Library matters will be kept withheld.
- Re-admission of unsuccessful students will be governed by "College Admission Rules".

Expulsion from any examination will lead to the expulsion from the College.

### C) College Uniform:

The College uniform is compulsory for every working day. Students without uniform will not be allowed to enter the college campus.

- For Boys: Sky Blue formal shirt and Navy Blue trouser
- For Girls: Sky blue Kurta, Navy Blue Pyjama and Dupata
- College badge to be collected from the office of the college.



### Support Services.

PDUAM, Tulungia has various support services to facilitate students' community. To improve the brotherhood and harmonious relationship among students community, the college has applied for the National Credit Crops (NCC).

- A pure drinking water facility has been provided inside the college building which was donated by the Bongaigaon Refinery & Petrochemicals Ltd. (BRPL) as part of their corporation Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative.
- To provide academic support to the poor and meritorious students, a book bank facility has been started in the central library of the college praying to all academic communities irrespective of their disciplines to donate their old and new books to help the needy students.
- To serve the quality and hygienic food to the students, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college a canteen facility has been provided within the college campus.
- Quarter facilities have been provided to all faculties (both teaching and non-teaching) of the college within the college campus.
- To maintain proper hygienic environment in the college campus, separate lavatory facilities have been set up for boys and girls student as well as in the case of teaching and non-teaching staff.

## College Library:

A library is the heart of an educational institution. Library of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya is not less than one which is located at the first floor of the college building with a very rich collection in various subjects covering all textbooks, reference books, journals and newspapers. Students may borrow books from the library against the Library Cards. They may read various newspapers and journals in the reading room of the library.

The central library is fully automated one. Integrated library management software SOUL 2.0 has been installed in the library in 2020. The library has a digital library section also through which library users can access different e-resources along with previous question papers, college journal, magazine, newsletter etc.

### General Library Rules.

1. Library membership can be achieved by filling up library membership form. Students must submit the following documents along with library membership form:
  - a) Photocopy of admission receipt.
  - b) Photocopy of address proof (Aadhar Card/Birth Certificate/Electricity Bill/Voter ID Card/Passport).
  - c) Two passport size photos.
2. A student must bring his/her library card to the library and can borrow maximum two books for a period of 15 days. He/she must return the books within 15 days from the date of issue, failure of which a late fine of Rs. 2.00 per day will be charged.
3. A book can be renewed for another 15 days (for one time only)
4. Students must deposit their belongings (Bag, mobile etc.) in the property counter before entering inside the library.
5. Students must put their Name, class/semester, roll no, purpose of visit, time of entry, time of departure and signature in the gate register at the time of entering into the library.

6. Silence shall be strictly observed in the library.
7. Conversation, making noise, spitting, and smoking inside the Library are strictly prohibited.
8. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in and around the library.
9. Students should carefully examine the books issued to them before leaving the Library Counter. They shall bring immediately to the notice of the librarian about any damage or mutilation of the book issued. Otherwise the borrower will be held responsible for any damage of mutilation and is required to replace it.

### Sports and Fitness (Gymnasium) Centre

To provide the proper physical education among students and faculty members of the college, a sport and fitness Centre has been set up with all modern equipments.

### Computer Lab

At the age of globalized world, the role of computer is not only essential for students community but for each and every individual also. With view to develop the knowledge on computer application in day to- day life, one computer lab has been set up with all modern amenities in the college including four digital-class rooms with overhead projectors. Further, PGDCA courses are proposed to be started from the next academic session.

### B. COURSES AND SUBJECTS.

#### 1. HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE (Commerce Stream):

English and MIL (Assamese)/Alt. English are core subjects and are compulsory. In addition, a candidate must study (i) Business Studies (ii) Accountancy (iii) Economics as compulsory elective subjects and either (i) Commercial Mathematics and Statistics or (ii) Finance or (iii) Computer Science as an optional fourth elective subject.

#### 2. HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE (Science Stream):

English and MIL (Assamese)/Alt. English are core subjects and are compulsory. In addition, a candidate needs to study i) Physics, ii) Chemistry, iii) Mathematics and iv) Biology or Computer Science.

#### 3. FOURYEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME (BA, B.Sc And B.Com As Per FYUGP) STRUCTURES AS PER NEP 2020 UNDER GAUHATI UNIVERSITY

The UG courses will be started from this session 2023-24 by the college as per the rules and regulation provided by Gauhati University under NEP 2020. The course structures under NEP 2020 are as follows:

The FYUGP at GU is designed to offer two types of Bachelor's Degrees to the students at the end of the successful completion of the programme—(i) Bachelor's Degree in a Stream and (ii) Bachelor's Degree in a Discipline. The word stream here refers to Arts, Science, Commerce, and Management. In case of a degree in a stream, the student studies a multitude of different subjects, usually mixing different disciplines, which leads to a truly multidisciplinary degree. While in case of a degree in a discipline, the student is confined to a certain sets of disciplines. However, in both cases, the student studies equal number of courses (i.e. papers)— so there is no weightage of any kind to either of the two types of degrees. For both the types of degree programmes, course-wise, the whole FYUGP is divided into two parts — (i) Core Courses and (ii) Common Courses. The minimum credit allocation for a 3-year programme is 84 credits in Core Courses and 36 credits in Common Courses, which comes to a total of minimum 120 credits for a 3-year programme. With the fourth year, the minimum credit requirements become 160. A student can however earn up to a maximum of 132 credits in a 3-year programme and 176 by the fourth year.

## Core Course Options Degree in a Stream

In what follows, we diagrammatically show three different options which a student can choose to complete a 3-year programme under the FYUGP.

- In this option, the student chooses a Major course and two Minor courses. With this option, the student will have 12 free credits, which s/he can utilise if s/he wants to.
- In the second option, the student has utilised this 12 free credits to complete one more Minor.
- The third option is when the student do not want any Major but wants to study all three courses equally. This option will be known as No Major (NOM) option. In this

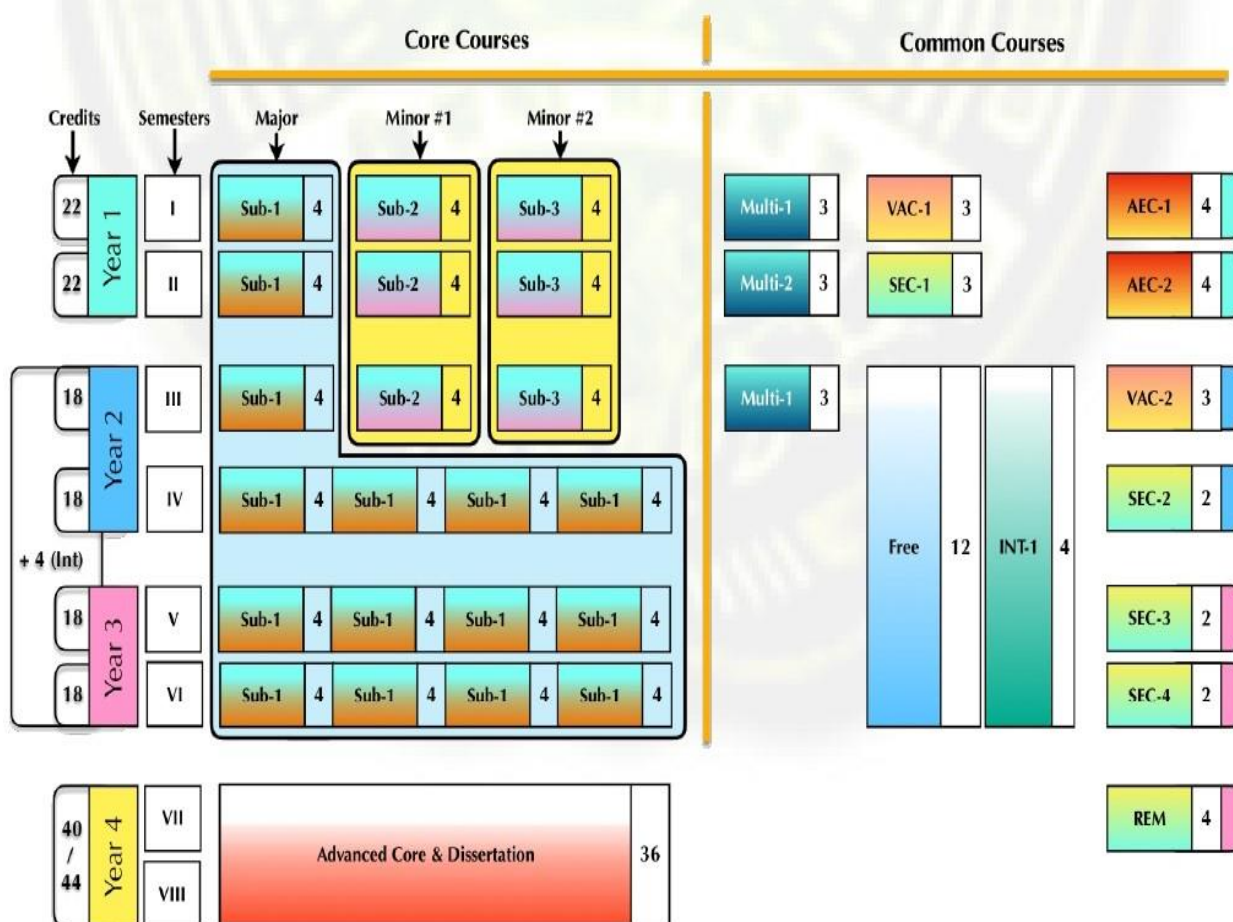


Figure. Core Courses Options- Options for a Major and Two Minors

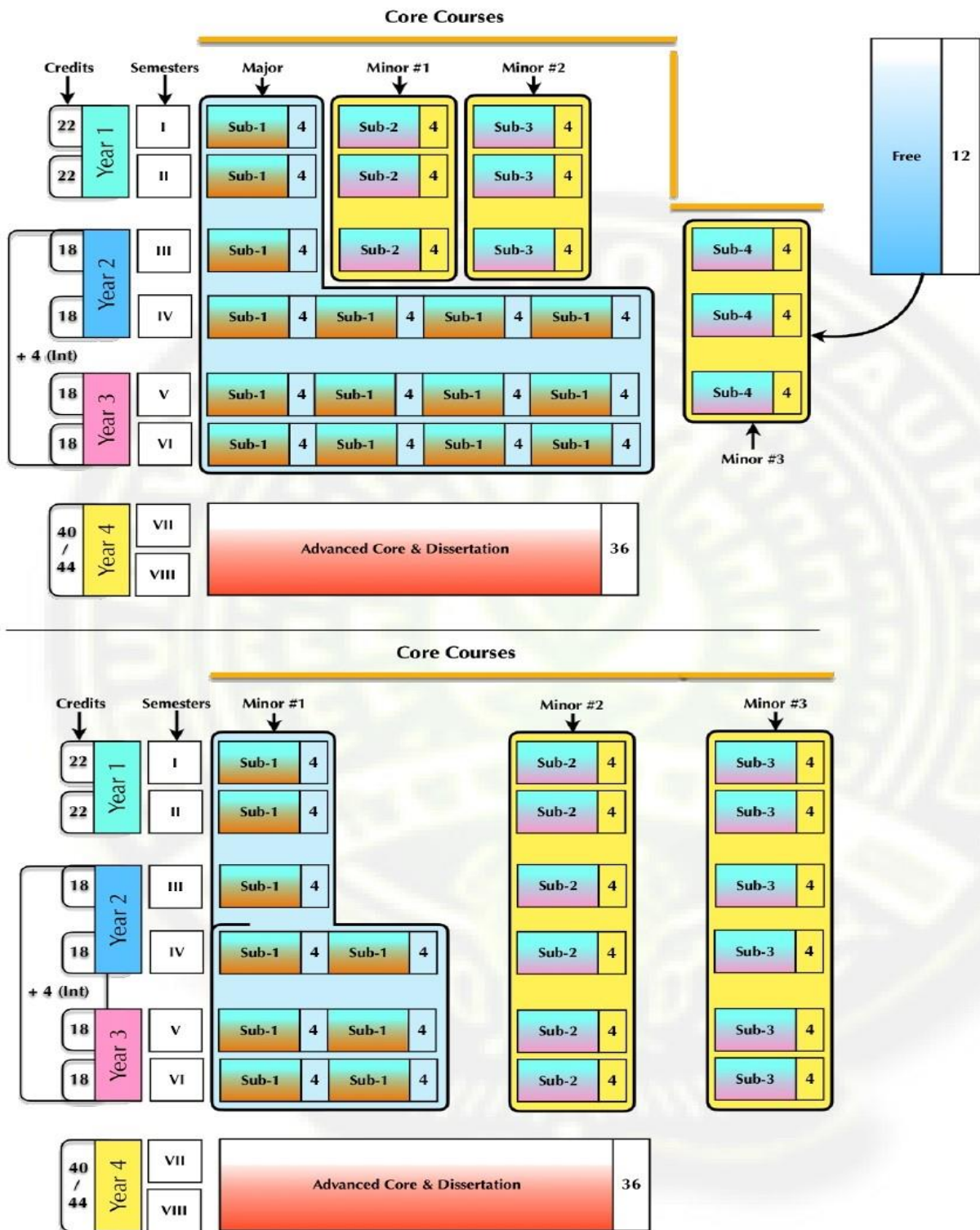


Figure. Core Courses Options- Option for a Major and Three Minors (Top) and option for a no Major option or NOM (Bottom)

Option, the students studies one paper from each of the three subjects in each semester from semester 1 to 6.

However, she/he will need to complete 12 more credits, which she/he can do by studying three courses (papers) from any of the three core subjects that she/he has chosen.





Admission to the B.Com 1st semester shall open only to those candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination in commerce, Science or Arts stream with a minimum of 45% subject to availability of seats. For B.Sc. 1<sup>st</sup> Semester only to those who have passed the HS examination in science with minimum of 45% subject to availability of seats. Similarly, for B.A. 1st semester shall open only to those candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination in Arts, commerce or Science stream with a minimum of 45% subject to availability of seats.

#### **Admission Procedure:**

##### **A. Eligibility Criteria:**

##### **1. Two-Year Higher Secondary Courses (Commerce/ Science)**

(i) Candidates who have passed HSLC or equivalent Exam from recognized Board are eligible to apply.

##### **2. Three-Year Degree Courses (Commerce, Science and Arts)**

(i) Candidates who have passed HSSLC Examination or equivalent from recognized Board/University are eligible to apply.

### D. Selection Criteria.

1. Admission to all courses of study is made strictly on the basis of merit, i.e., the percentage of marks obtained in the last qualifying examination.
2. Reservation of seats will be as per following norms:
  - a) There is a provision for reservation of seats, as per Govt. of Assam rules [OBC/MOBC– 27%, SC–7%, ST(P) – 10% , ST(H) – 5%, UR (EWS) 10%] for SC,ST(P), ST(H), OBC/MOBC candidates belonging to the state of Assam and in this respect, caste certificate issued by the competent authority under Govt. of Assam only shall be valid.
3. The candidates seeking admission to HS 1<sup>st</sup> Year or TDC First semester must pass the last qualifying Exam. The candidates, who passed the last qualifying Examination in before 2024 and applying for admission, must produce **GAP CERTIFICATE in ORIGINAL** along with the application form on the day of admission. The competent authority from whom GAP CERTIFICATE should be obtained is as follows:

- a) Medical officers not below the rank of Medical Superintendent with his/her contact number.
  - b) The Head Master/Principal where the candidates studied last certifying that the candidate is well known to him/her along with the contact number.
  - c) The Block Development Officer (BDO) certifying that the candidate is well known to him/her along with the contact number.
4. The list of the selected candidates will be notified in the college website and admitted as per Admission Schedule.
  5. If a candidate fails to report on the day of admission as per list and schedule, his/her candidature will be forfeited.
  6. The decision of the *ADMISSION COMMITTEE* will be binding and final.
  7. Doubtful documents will be subjected to verification to the issuing authority / seizure of documents / may be followed by action of law.
  8. A General Waiting list of candidates who may be called for admission will be notified in due course of time. Admission of the candidates from the Waiting List may be considered on the last day of the scheduled dates depending upon the number of vacant seats.
- The student seeking admission in the **college hostel** must collect a separate application form the office of the college and has to be submitted within the stipulated time.
